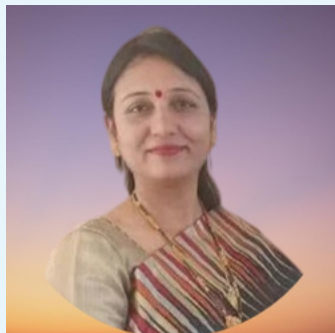
## From the Director's Desk

Here, she presented an insightful paper titled “Study of the Effect of Parenting Style on Aggression of Higher Secondary Education Level Students,” contributing valuable research to the academic community.
- Boskey Pancholi also made significant contributions to academic discourse by actively engaging in the National Workshop on “Research Methodology: Hypothesis Framing and Testing.”

This workshop, held on March 10, 2025, was organized by the Research and Development cell of Government Arts Girls College, Kota, and focused on enhancing participants' research skills.

- Furthermore, Dr. Pancholi expanded her professional development by participating in the National Workshop for the Faculty Development Program.

This program, which took place from January 27 to 31, 2026, at J.D.B. Govt. Girls College, Kota, concentrated on the operation and maintenance of laboratory instruments, equipping faculty with essential technical skills.

Published in the Global Journal for Research Analysis, this paper delves into the complexities of diagnosing and managing these medical conditions, offering valuable insights for the medical community.
- In 2026, Dr. Boskey Pancholi, alongside Dr. Bharatiy Sharma, explored the "Nutraceutical Potential of Indian Herbs with Hair Cleansing Properties." Their research involved formulating, evaluating, and comparing a herbal shampoo to commercial alternatives. This work, accepted for publication in the Asian Journal of Pharmaceutical Research, underscores the therapeutic benefits of traditional herbs in modern applications.
- Dr. Boskey Pancholi and Sushil Kumar Barolia conducted a study on the "Anti-mosquitocidal Activity of Four Indian Medicinal Plants Extracts." Their findings, soon to be published in the Journal of Vector Borne Diseases, contribute significantly to the ongoing research on natural mosquito control methods, emphasizing the importance of medicinal plants in vector management.
- Dr. Shivali Kharoliwal submitted a project proposal under the IKSBG Samvardhan Yojana scheme, organized by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, for the 2026-27 period. Her proposal aims to contribute to national educational initiatives, reflecting her commitment to advancing educational and environmental projects.
